CHURCHES ENTER NEW PHASE

The Diocese of El Paso entered a new phase of its pandemic protocols on June 1, 2021. The capacity for church gatherings is increased to 100%, but **masks must be worn by all members of the assembly**, and everyone should sanitize their hands when entering the church.

- Gatherings in other indoor spaces, such as group meetings or classes, can be at 100% capacity if all participants have been vaccinated.
- Though the CDC has recently recommended that fully vaccinated people may resume activities without wearing a mask, there are still far too many people in our community who are not vaccinated (including all children under age 12). Because our churches are places of close gathering indoors where singing and vocal responses are common, our churches will continue to require the wearing of masks for now.
- Communion may only be received in the hand, a manner that is reverent and part of the long-standing tradition of the Church, and only in the form of the Body of Christ (the host), not the shared chalice. Holy water fonts that contain standing water, like those at church entrances, are also not yet permitted.

With these changes, we hope to allow more people to gather to celebrate their faith, but in a prudent way that keeps everyone safe. We continue to pray for a prompt end to the pandemic, as well as for all those who have died from this disease. But we also pray for the patience to endure what we hope are the waning months of pandemic-related restrictions, as well as for the courage to perform everyday acts of Christian charity to keep each other healthy.

LAS IGLESIAS ENTRAN EN NUEVA FASE

La Diócesis de El Paso entró en una nueva fase de sus protocolos de pandemia el 1º de junio de 2021. La capacidad para las reuniones de la iglesia se incrementa al 100%, pero **todos los miembros de la asamblea deben usar cubrebocas**, y todos deben desinfectarse las manos al entrar a la iglesia.

- Las reuniones en otros espacios interiores, como reuniones de grupos o clases, pueden estar al 100% de su capacidad si todos los participantes han sido vacunados.
- Aunque el CDC ha recomendado recientemente que las personas completamente vacunadas puedan reanudar sus actividades sin usar cubrebocas, todavía hay demasiadas personas en nuestra comunidad que no están vacunadas (incluidos todos los niños menores de 12 años). Debido a que nuestras iglesias son lugares de reunión cercana en interiores donde el canto y las respuestas vocales son comunes, nuestras iglesias continuarán requiriendo el uso de cubrebocas por ahora.
- La comunión sólo puede ser recibida en la mano, una manera que es reverente y parte de la larga tradición de la Iglesia, y sólo en la forma del Cuerpo de Cristo (la hostia), no el cáliz compartido. Las fuentes de agua bendita que contienen agua estancada, como las de las entradas de las iglesias, tampoco están permitidas todavía.

Con estos cambios, esperamos permitir que más personas se reúnan para celebrar su fe, pero de una manera prudente que mantenga a todos a salvo. Seguimos orando por el pronto fin de la pandemia, así como por todos los que han muerto a causa de esta enfermedad. Pero también oramos por la paciencia para soportar lo que esperamos que sean los meses menguantes de restricciones relacionadas con la pandemia, así como por el coraje de realizar actos cotidianos de caridad cristiana para mantenernos sanos unos a otros. *Obispo Mark Seitz*
