Dear Parishioners:

All over California, winegrowers are picking, racking, and punching down. They are currently right in the middle of the wine harvest season! This is quite a contrast of what is happening in other places. Half-way across the continental United States, our own state suffered flooding after Hurricane Harvey, destroying homes, overturning vehicles and sinking boats, severing power lines, and forcing tens of thousands of residents to flee. Going eastward, farmers should be beginning their harvest. However, in Florida farmers suffered 80 to 90 percent losses in their crops in parts of the state after Hurricane Irma flattened greenhouses, toppled trees and flooded pastures as it tore through the state. Farmers lost part of their sugar cane and citrus crops. Storm-battered Puerto Rico, with a population of 3.4 million, is still without electricity after Hurricane Maria struck with ferocious winds and torrential rains. Our neighbors in Mexico suffered a 7.1 magnitude earthquake on the anniversary of the worst earthquake in Mexico's history, the 1985 earthquake. Rescue teams are still digging through the rubble for signs of life. Let us continue to offer our prayers for our brothers and sisters who are still working hard to rebuild their lives after suffering from these acts of nature. Thank you so much for your donations to the Hurricane Harvey relief fund. This coming weekend, September 30 and October 1st, we will be taking a collection for the Hurricane Maria relief fund. This fund will help the people of Florida and the Caribbean Islands, including Puerto Rico. We are also taking donations for the people of Mexico. A complete list can be found in the announcements in this newsletter.

On another note, as you have noticed, our stained glass project in the sanctuary has been completed. Actually this phase of the work is done. I would like to thank all parishioners who were involved in this project. I would like to give a great big **THANK YOU** to Jesse Favela and Santiago Romero for the countless hours they spent on the frames and stained glass. If you have noticed, the stained glass window has also been installed. This is the window that suffered wind damage several years ago. I love the ambiance. We are surrounded by beautiful artwork. Interestingly, the artisans who made the frames for the stained glass are the same artisans who made the papal chair and other items for the altar for the mass during Pope Francis' visit to Cd. Juarez last year. What an honor to have those same hands make the frames for our beautiful church. We are so blessed.

There is still much to do to our church. We need an ambry in which to store our holy oils. Some people have recommended adding another stained glass frame in the sanctuary for symmetry. Now that we see how much beauty the stained glass window adds, some people would like have all clear windows in the church replaced with stained glass. We also need to replace our heating and cooling in the church. Thank you for your contributions to the Building Fund and for making this possible, one step at a time.

This month we will celebrate our parish feast. We will have our open-air mass at Memorial Park, followed by a picnic. Additional information is also included in this newsletter.

All Saints has been so blessed in having Father Juan Antonio. He respects the people of All Saints and our parish is near and dear to his heart. We are so grateful for all that he has done for us. The Franciscan province moved Father Daniel to Mexico and we now welcome Father Andres Sosa to All Saints. Father Andres will be celebrating the Spanish mass and Father Juan Antonio will continue to celebrate the English masses.

DISASTER RELIEF – EARTHQUAKE IN MEXICO

The state of Puebla in Mexico suffered a devastating earthquake on September 19. Many have already responded with long hours of rescue efforts while others have opened their homes to shelter the homeless. The Diocese of El Paso is coordinating a drive with the mayor of Cd. Juarez. The people of Puebla are in need of the following items: **water, toiletries, non-perishable foods, baby food, diapers, dog & cat food as well as monetary funds (please no clothes)**. You can also drop off your items at All Saints by **12:00 noon on October 1st**. A basket for these items is available at all entrances to the church.
