TEXT GIVING by texting the amount to **915-233-1814**.

The first time you use this, add the number to your contacts. Text the word **Give**. You will receive a text with a link to complete your check or card information. This information is secure. The second and subsequent times you use text giving, all you need to text is the amount, using the dollar amount such as \$10 or \$20 whatever amount you want to donate. Send the text and you're all set.

IN PERSON: Drop your envelope it in our mailbox.
